Gospel on Laetare Sunday... rejoice!

1st Reading: 2 Chronicles 36:14-16, 19-23

Second Reading: Ephesians 2: 4-10

Gospel: John 3:14-21

4th Sunday of Lent - Laetare Sunday, Rejoice! This Sunday is known as Laetare Sunday. Laetare, meaning "Rejoice" comes from the entrance antiphon

reflecting on Isaiah 66:10-11: "Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her. Similar to Guadete Sunday celebrated on the Third Sunday of Advent, on Laetare

Sunday the Church expresses hope and joy in the midst of our Lenten fasts and penances. In Advent, we recognize that "light" is dispelling the darkness. In

today's Gospel, Nicodemus comes to Jesus in the darkness of the night and

encounters a light that provides truth, "Whoever lives the truth comes to the light, so that his works may be seen as done in God." Today's Gospel stresses the importance of faith. All who believe in Jesus, who died and rose for us, have

eternal life. God sent his Son into the world so that it might be saved, and not to

condemn it. Jesus is the key to salvation. This is the light of truth shared in the
