

Snow Angels for God

Well winter is finally here. We have a return of the cold and the snow. It is also the time of year to make snow people, build snow caves, and have snowball fights. But one other fun and common thing to do is to make a snow angel. To make this you must carefully fall backwards into the snow with your arms spread out wide and then you move you legs and arms together and apart to form the angel's body and wings. My second point with snow angels, especially ones where we have friends helping us get out of our perfect snow angel, is that we are all called to be "angels" to each other. We obviously are not true angels since God created us as humans but that doesn't mean we can't be "angels" to each other. Sometimes even the smallest thing we do can be a great help to another person. Shoveling a neighbor's steps, walk a small sign in the snow to say hello to others, even simple things as smiling and saying hello when you walk pass someone. All these things are small ways that can have a major impact on others and help them want to spread the good felling. There are many stories where I here of a



friend just randomly call to talk or a stranger walking past them on the street or in a store and just smiling and saying hello. This has told me how this has helped them get through the bad and remember that God and others are there with and for them. So, take advantage of the snow and go make some snow angels to help remember that angels are there for us and that we can be angels to others.

Saint Valentine, officially known as Saint Valentine of Rome, is a third-century Roman saint widely celebrated on February 14 and commonly associated with "courtly love." Although not much of St. Valentine's life is reliably known, and whether or not the stories involve two different saints by the same name is also not officially decided, it is highly agreed that St. Valentine was martyred and then buried on the Via Flaminia to the north of Rome. St. Valentine refused to renounce his faith and Christianity and was executed outside the Flaminian Gate on February 14, 269. However, other tales of St. Valentine's life claim he was executed either in the year 269, 270, 273 or 280. Other depictions of St. Valentine's arrests tell that he secretly married couples so

husbands wouldn't have to go to war. Another variation of the legend of St. Valentine says he refused to sacrifice to pagan gods, was imprisoned and while imprisoned he healed the jailer's blind daughter. On the day of his execution, he left the girl a note signed, "Your Valentine.

It's so cold that there were iceberg warnings issued for Onondaga Lake.


It's so cold that I had to use the ice scraper on my car windows, then my cell phone, and my eyeglasses.
