#### **CHOOSING A CONFIRMATION SPONSOR & SAINT NAME**

#### **S**PONSOR

A sponsor is a person who encourages and assists a candidate to embrace and actively practice the Catholic faith both before and after Confirmation. You should choose someone that you can talk to about your faith, who will be a good role model for you, and who will take an active role as your sponsor. Since parents are the primary faith educators, they already have an important role in your faith journey and may not serve as sponsors.

#### Requirements to be a Confirmation Sponsor

- Must be at least 16 years of age.
- May not be the parent of the candidate.
- Has received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation.
- Is a registered member of a parish, a practicing Catholic and is able to receive the Sacraments.
- If married, be in a canonically valid marriage recognized by the Roman Catholic Church.
- Must have the intention of encouraging the candidate to be a true witness to the Catholic Faith by actively practicing their faith.

#### SAINT NAME

The tradition of taking on a new name to show a new role can be traced back to the Old Testament. When Abram was called to lead his people to believe in the one true God, his name was changed from Abram to Abraham meaning "the father of many nations." Again, in the New Testament we find Simon's name changed from Simon to Peter, meaning "Rock" because he was to become the rock upon which Jesus founded His Church. Likewise, your Confirmation Name should reflect the NEW role you will undertake as a more mature Catholic.

Your Confirmation name should be the name of a Catholic Saint. You can choose your baptismal name, or you can choose a completely new name. The name you select can be to honor someone in your life (parent, grandparent, etc.) whom you respect and admire for their example of love and holiness.

Don't just pick a name you like - Know your Saint! Research the lives of Catholic Saints and see which Saint reflects a virtue or value you wish to aspire to; or, perhaps the patron Saint of your life's interest or passion. The goal is to pick the name of a Saint you admire, can relate to, or aspire to be like.
